# Research Process

## PHASE I Expectations, Goals, Participation

### Baseline

- Telephone Interviews  
Post meeting 1  
Sept/Oct 2010
- Online Survey
- SNA  
At Meeting 2

Phone Interview responses = 21  
On-line Survey responses = 13  
SNA = 100% of respondents = 21

## PHASE II Group Dynamics

### Continuous

- Participant Observation
- Evaluation Exit Surveys
- Feedback into meeting planning (activities)

2014 Meeting 10 = 101 People in network

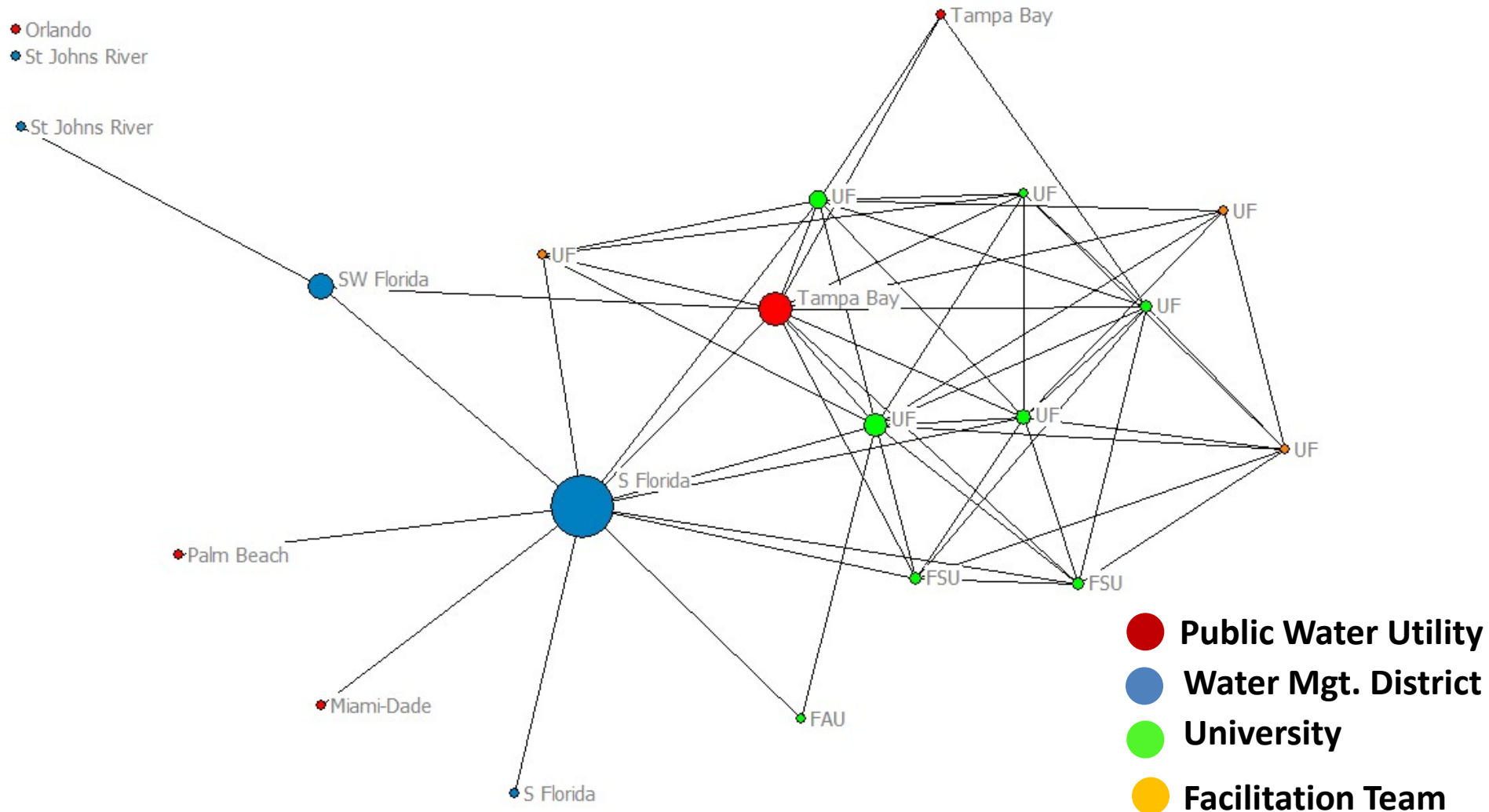

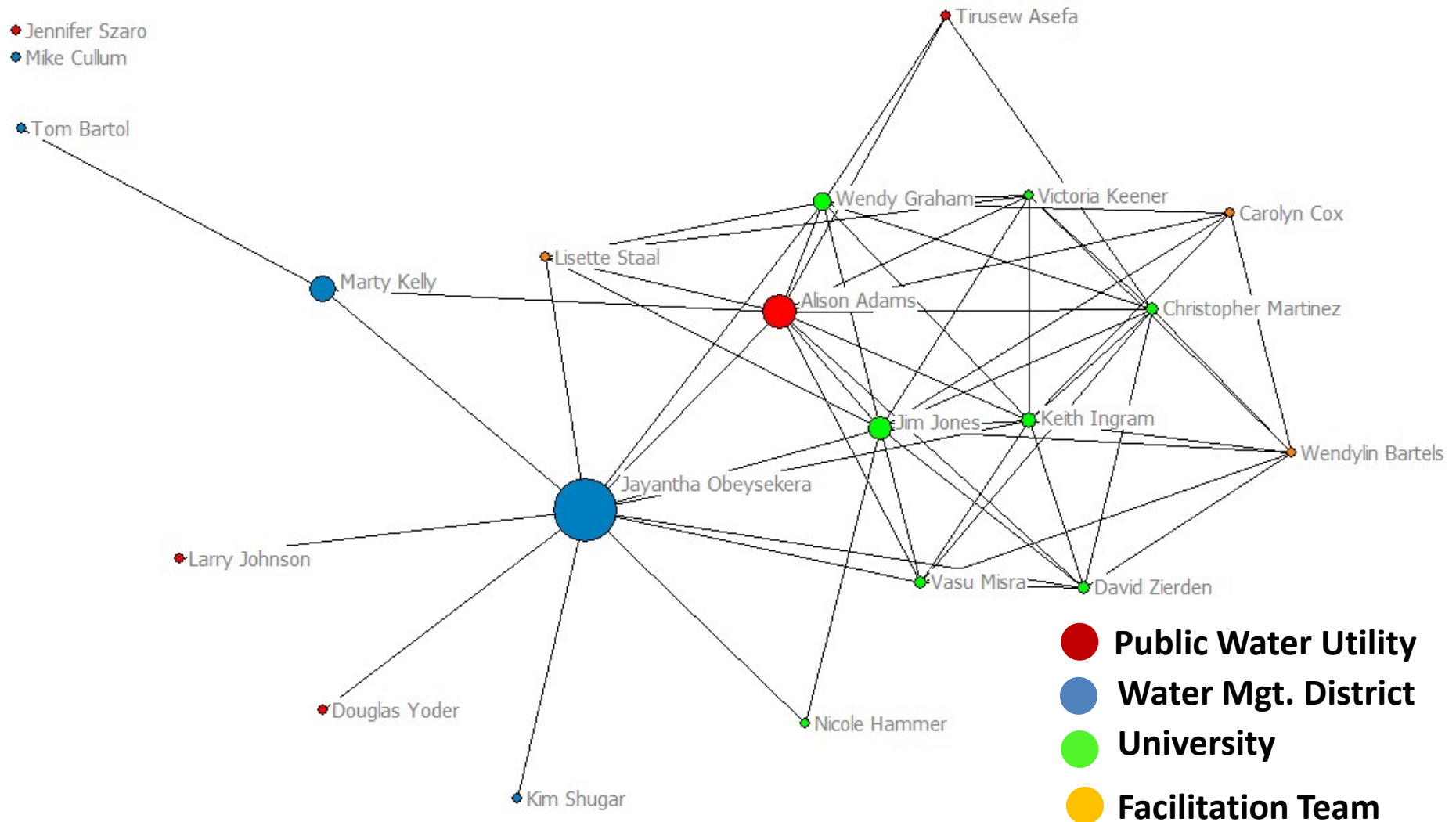


# Institutions that exchanged climate-related information in 2010

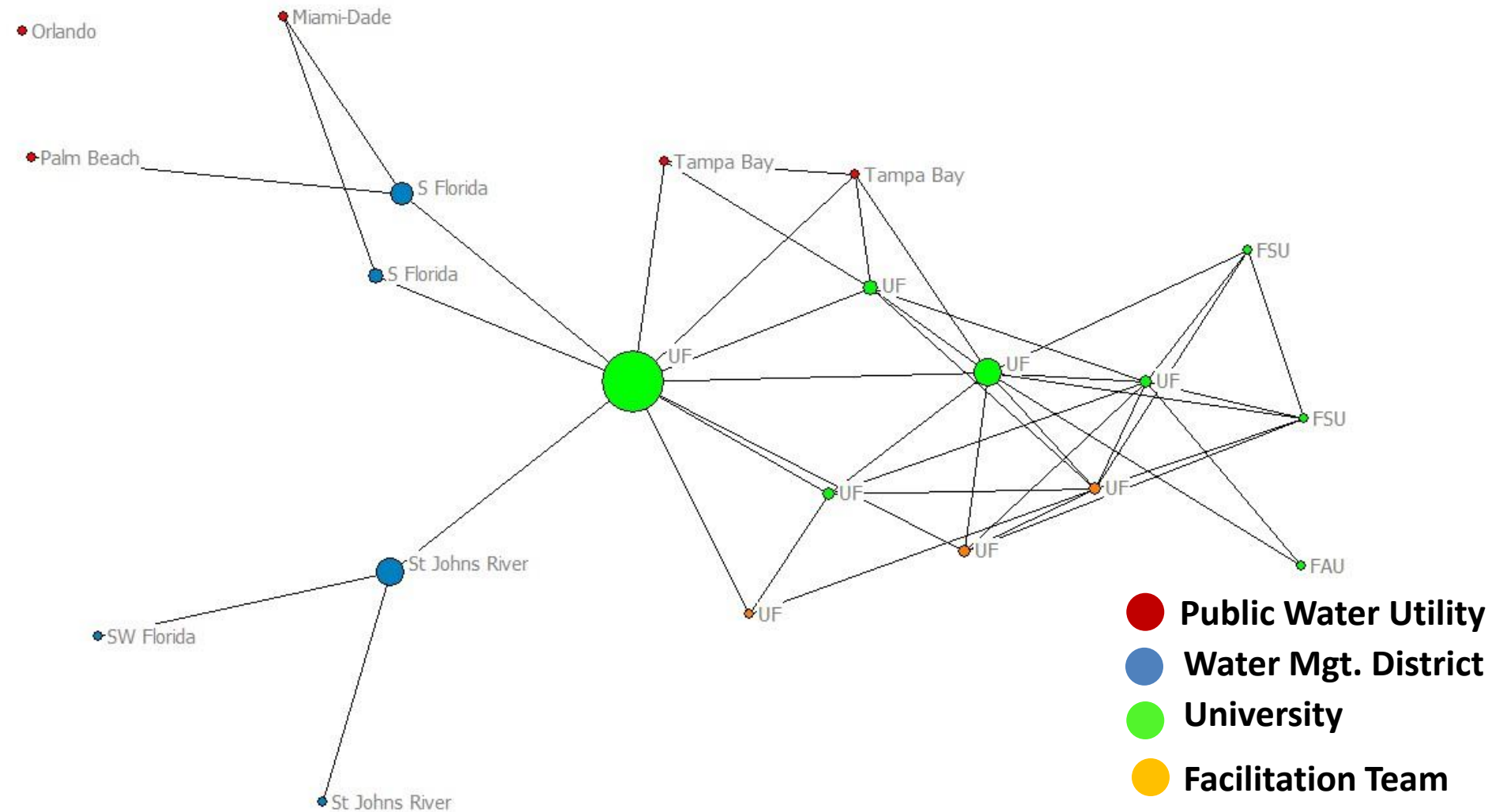




# People that exchanged climate-related information in 2010

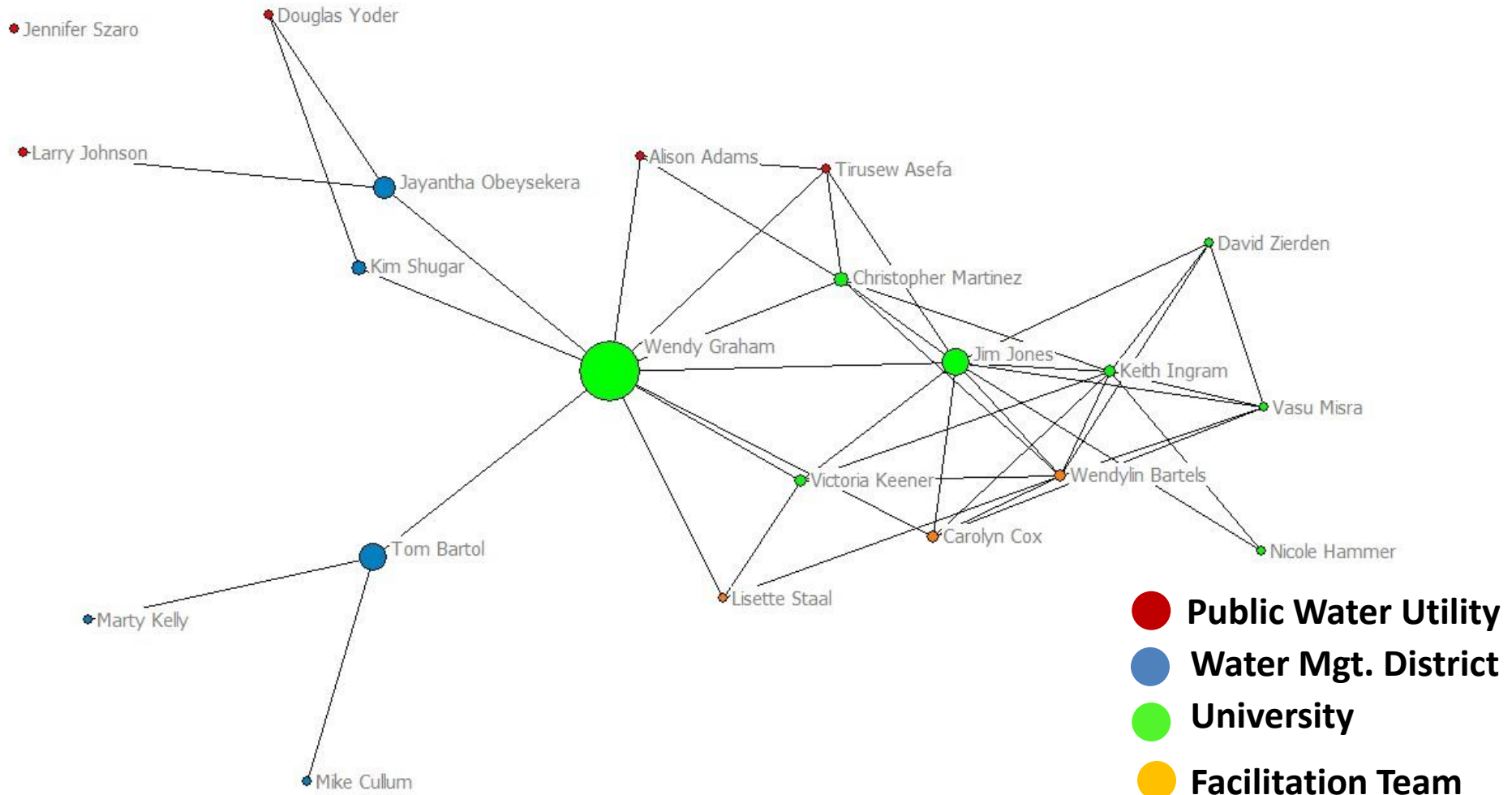


# Institutions that partnered on projects in 2010
